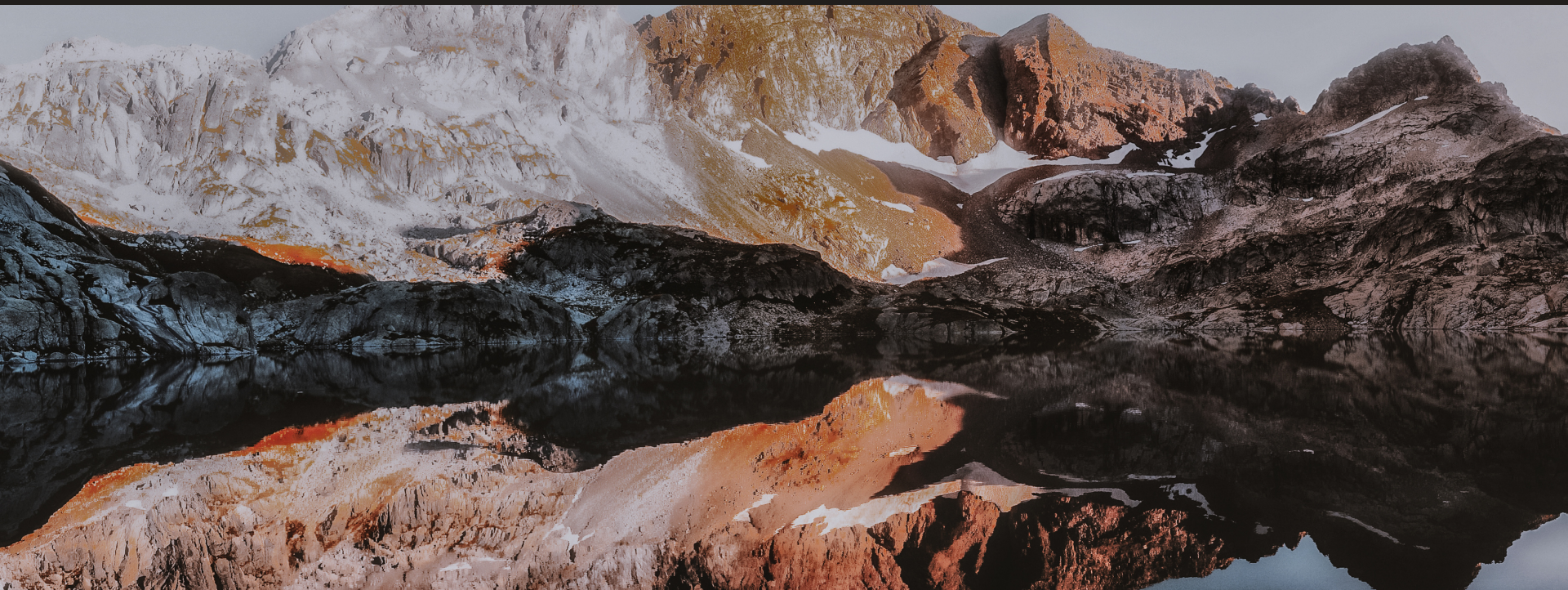


To begin, I'd like to invite you to think about this question: What are three things you're certain of in this life? Share them with the person next to you
